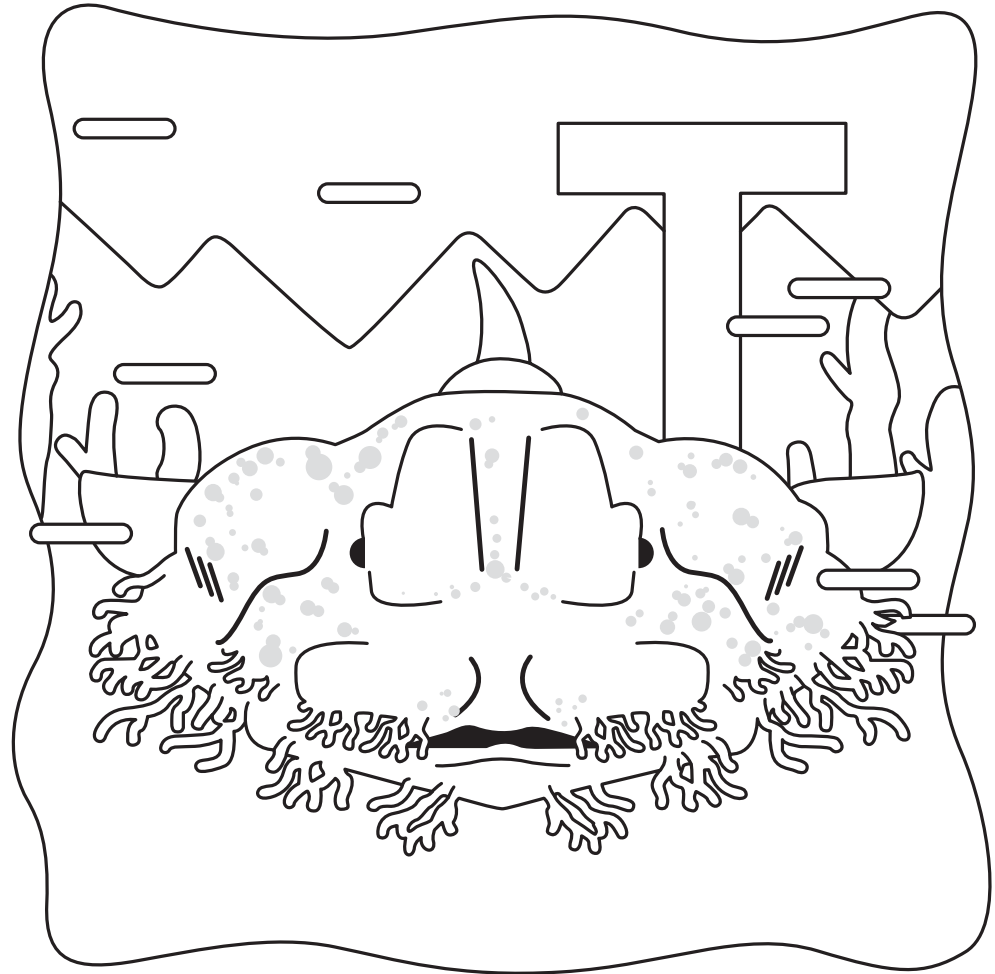
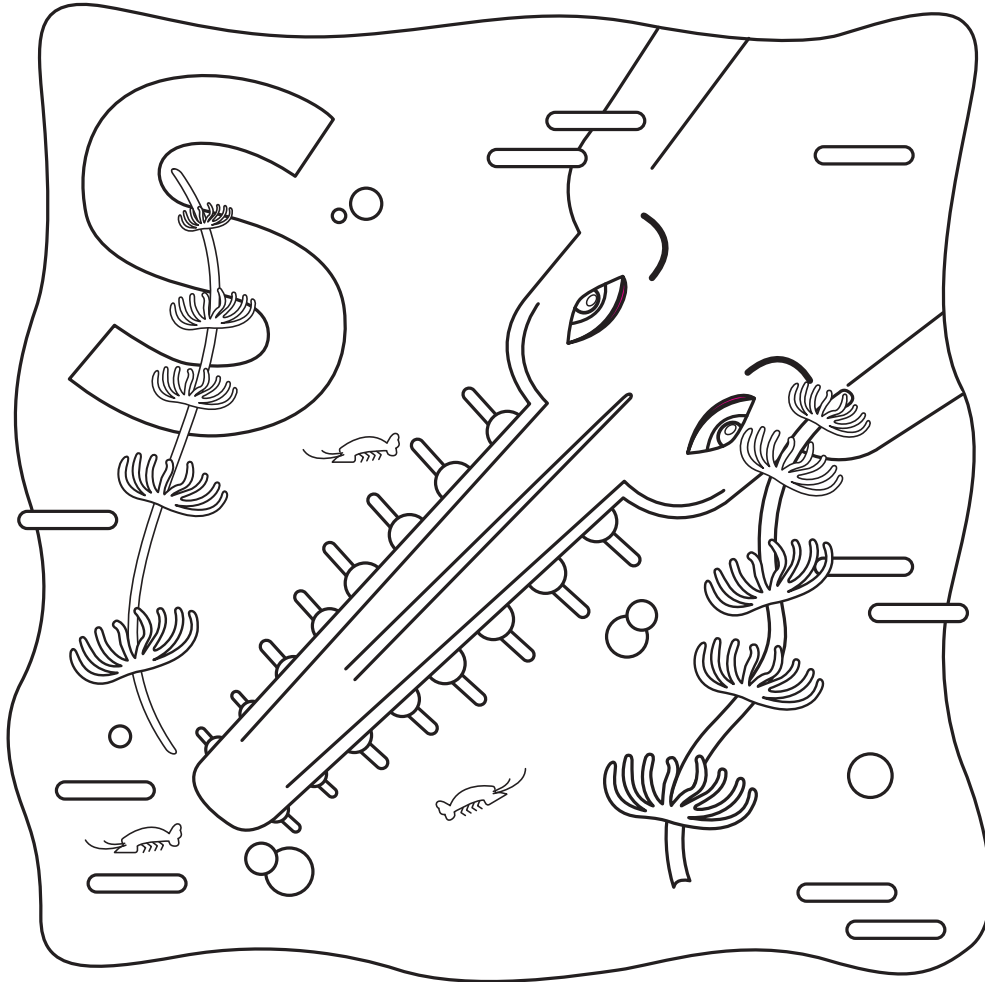


S is for Sawfish
